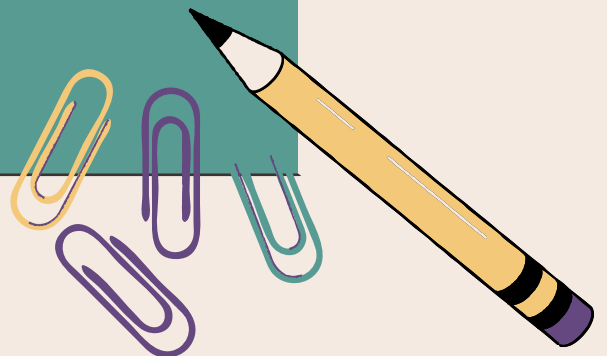




THE FIVE STRATEGIES

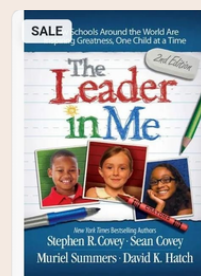


Quick Action Tip:

Cultivating a growth mindset isn't just about what you teach; it's about **modeling the power of curiosity and self-improvement**.

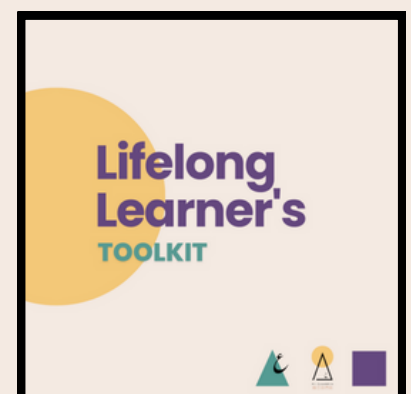
Quick Action Tip:

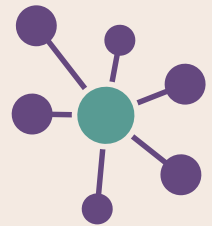




Strategy 3: Create Meaningful Connections

Build a classroom where **students feel valued and respected**, and a team culture where **colleagues support each other's growth**.

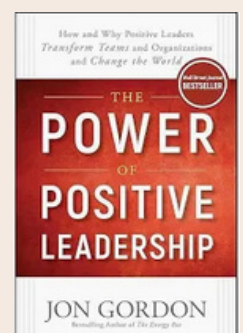


Quick Action Tip:

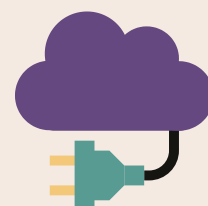




Strategy 4: Empower with Confidence

Quick Action Tip:

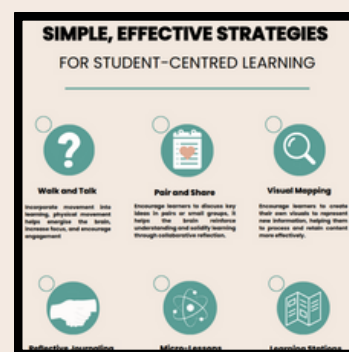


Identify one responsibility or small task you can delegate to a student or colleague. Allow them the chance to lead in their own way, and be there for support if needed.

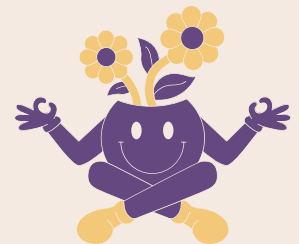




Strategy 5: Model Resilience and Self-Care

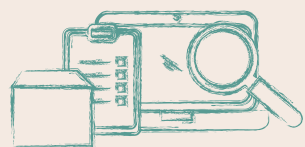

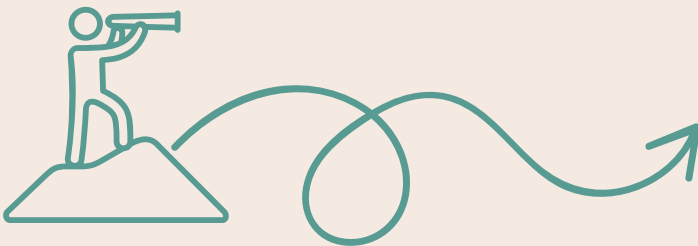
